Medicare Qualifications

To qualify for Medicare reimbursed home health services, Medicare requires patients to be homebound. This simply means that leaving the home requires a taxing effort or the assistance of others and that trips away from the home are, therefore, infrequent. Patients can be temporarily homebound due to injury or illness. Patients must also need the skilled services of a nurse or therapist. While personal care from aides is a covered service, the need for this service alone cannot justify a Medicare home health episode. Your doctor must certify your home health care. Integrity will coordinate with your doctor directly.
